Each alabaster light is unique and accented with solid brass detailing that matches our wider collections.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT WITH ALABASTER LIGHTING

Alabaster is a naturally translucent stone renowned for its unique veining, cream undertones and soft, ambient glow, making it ideal for luxury lighting. Each alabaster light is completely unique due to the stone's organic variations and tone, meaning no two designs are alike. While lighter than marble, alabaster is heavy and porous, so the lights should be correctly maintained and cared for.

### **CLEANING & CARE**

Before you begin cleaning your alabaster light, always ensure the fixture is switched off and handle it with care to preserve its natural beauty. Gently dust the alabaster surface using a soft, dry microfiber cloth.

For the brass detailing, use a dry or slightly damp soft microfiber cloth to maintain the finish. Once you have cleaned your alabaster light, always ensure all parts are securely reassembled after cleaning. By cleaning regularly with care, you'll preserve the alabaster surface for many years to come.

#### WHAT SHOULD I AVOID?

When caring for alabaster lighting, it's important to avoid harsh or abrasive cleaners, chemical solvents and acidic substances, as these can damage the delicate stone and brass finish. Never rub the alabaster surface excessively, as this may cause scratches, staining or dull its natural smooth texture.

Alabaster is a porous material, so it should be kept away from areas with direct moisture or steam, and out of prolonged direct sunlight to prevent discolouration. Avoid using too much water to prevent water stains and moisture damage. Finally, due to the weight and fragility of alabaster, fixtures should always be installed by a professional to ensure safety and stability.
